



Locker Room Misconduct Policy

Fox Chapel Killer Whales Swimming

EXPECTATIONS

The Fox Chapel Killer Whales (FCKW) regularly reminds swimmers of Safe Sport locker room policies.

- FCKW swimmers are expected to demonstrate a high level of personal character. The use of poor language, inappropriate discussions, and general roughhousing in the locker room is unacceptable and should be reported to a FCKW coach as soon as possible.
- FCKW swimmers or family members that observe any concerning or inappropriate behavior should report the information to a FCKW coach as soon as possible.
- FCKW directly addresses issues with the parties involved and gets parents involved as necessary.
- For serious, team wide, or repeat issues, the appropriate actions will be taken to ensure the safety of all FCKW swimmers and participants, including up to permanent suspension.

MISCONDUCT STEPS

Misconduct and monitored problematic behavior in the locker rooms will not be tolerated.

Minors

- First offence: Swimmer, parent and coach will discuss the behavior and ways to correct the issue.
- Second offence: Swimmer will no longer have use of locker room area, must come to practice changed and ready to go, and will leave practice without going into the locker room.
- Third offence: Swimmer will be suspended from the team.

Adults

Any adult displaying misconduct or problematic behavior in the locker rooms will not be tolerated, and the Fox Chapel Police will be notified.
